<p>County or Orange Social Services Agency – Family Self-Sufficiency</p>	<p>Administers cash aid, medical benefits and financial assistance for food (CalWORKS, Medi-Cal and CalFresh) for the care of children in need when one or both parents are unable to provide care due to absence, unemployment, disability or death. Clients apply for all three benefits at once, and qualified families may receive one or more of the following programs:</p> <p>CalWORKs (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) provides cash aid (through a re-chargeable electronic card (Electronic Benefits Transfer or "EBT" card) that is used like an ATM card) and support services to families.
